






Background

- Population ageing is one of the challenges of the 21st century affecting:
 - Pensions, health and long-term care
 - Economic growth and living standards
 - Social (esp. intergenerational) cohesion
- Financial, debt and economic crisis has made matters worse
- ▶ Genuine EU challenge, not only member states
- Requires monitoring and benchmarking
- ▶ Age 50+ shows what welfare state interventions have accumulated over the life-course: health, wealth, and social networks









SHARE ERIC

- SHARE ERIC (Commission decision March 17, 2011)
- Participation
 - AT, BE, CZ, DE (coordination and future host), IT, NL (current host)
 - CH observer
 - ▶ SI and IL in formal process of accession [Σ =9]
 - DK, ES, FR, PT formal letter of intention to sign [4]
 - all other countries still discussing [7]
- What changed?
 - legal entity, organizational framework, governance
 - a long term perspective (6 more panel waves up to 2024)
 - streamlined procurement rules, VAT exemption
- However, **still a rough road** to have ERIC accepted as European instrument (ERIC data sets SHARE and ESS not members of the system of EU statistics)












Organisational challenges of a fully distributed RI

20 independent survey agencies & about 2000 mostly free-lance interviewers



Harmonization? Project schedule
















Sustainability

Wave 5 funding during the debt crisis: Pretest & training done in all countries, but main field again postponed in many countries

Funding for survey is still not secured in all countries

- **HU**
- Remember: Genuine European challenge, requires monitoring and benchmarking
- Data for policies comparisons, failures and successes provides EU added value
